3.3.1 - Does your university as a body have current collaborations with local, national or global health institutions to improve health & wellbeing outcomes?

An agreement of cooperation was signed between Al-Noor University, represented by its dean Prof. Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar and the College of Health and Medical Techniques, represented by its dean Assistant Professor Dr. Miada Nouri Iqbal, at the premises of the Central Technical University in Baghdad on Wednesday,16/11/2022. The agreement aims to enhance the level of both Universities and includes cooperation in curriculum development, textbook exchange, conducting training workshops, and mutual agreement on delivering theoretical lectures and conducting joint examinations for students, in accordance with ministerial directives.








"Within the framework of direct scientific cooperation and exchange of experience between higher education institutions in Nineveh and with the approval of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, with God's help, a twinning agreement was signed between the mother of the universities in Nineveh Governorate, the University of Mosul and the Narcissus flower of the Private Higher Education, Al-Noor University. The ceremonies took place on Thursday morning, 29/8/2019, in the University Council Hall on the site of the University's Scientific and Literary Forum, which had witnessed, over a decade and more, the establishment of most of the major and sober scientific activities of a central nature for the University and various higher education institutions.

The signing ceremony included a speech by Professor Dr. Qusay Kamal Al-Din Al-Ahmadi, President of the University of Mosul, and Professor Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, Dean of Al-Noor University ... after they exchanged signatures on both copies of the agreement..

The signing ceremony was attended by the University of Mosul's two assistants to the university's president, namely Professor Dr. Mufid Thanoun Younis, assistant to the university's president for scientific affairs, and Professor Dr. Akram Mahmoud Hussein, assistant to the university's president for administrative affairs, and the deans of the relevant colleges. It was attended by Dr. Nabil Ahmed Jarjis, from Al-Noor University, Assistant Dean for Administrative Affairs, and heads of departments corresponding to the faculties of the University of Mosul.

With this date, a new door opens between the University of Mosul and Al-Noor University for Scientific and Knowledge Communication, adding to the history of cooperation that already existed between them. The media team at Al-Noor University attended this historical moment and documented it in eloquent, indicative images that express its depth and meaning..."








"On Monday, 20/1/2020, in the meeting hall of the college council, Al-Noor University College and Nineveh University signed a twinning agreement. The agreement aimed to enhance cooperation between Iraqi higher education institutions in areas such as exchanging expertise, mutual support in organizing scientific activities, and sharing resources. The agreement was signed by Prof. Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, the dean of Al-Noor University College, and Prof. Dr. Mazahim Qasim Al-Khayat, the president of Nineveh University. Prior to the signing, Prof. Dr. Yassin Taha illuminated the history and current status of the college, emphasizing its achievements with precise statistics. He commended the role of Prof Dr. Yassar Yahya Al-Tammar, the head of the Department of Medical Laboratory Techniques, for his coordination and preparation for the agreement. Following this, Prof. Dr. Mazahim Qasim Al-Khayat spoke about the development and solidity of Al-Noor University College, praising its faculty and students. He expressed Nineveh University's readiness to engage in the agreement with its senior officials, extending his gratitude to Dr. Yassar Yahya Al-Tammar and the two deputy presidents of Nineveh University for their efforts in finalizing the agreement. Subsequently, the dean of Al-Noor University College presented the twinning shield to the president of Nineveh University. A delegation from Nineveh University then visited the college to explore its facilities, laboratories, and available resources."

The signing ceremony was attended by representatives from Nineveh University, including the two assistant vice presidents for academic and administrative affairs, the deans of the College of Medicine and the College of Electronics Engineering, as well as heads of scientific and administrative departments, and media personnel. From Al-Noor University College, the college council, academic affairs department, monitoring and follow-up department, and media team were present at the ceremony








"In completing the cooperation programs between Al-Noor University College and higher education institutions, the college signed on Monday morning, corresponding to 3/2/2020, a twinning agreement with Al-Hamdaniya University, which shares the geographical location and is active in serving Iraqi higher education near it. The signing ceremony of the agreement took place in the Council Hall of Al-Noor University College.

Initially, Prof. Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, the dean of Al-Noor University College, began by illuminating the significance of the rich scholarly connection between the two parties. He then shed light on Al-Noor University's path in establishment, advancement, and overcoming the hurdles imposed by terrorist groups on the scientific life in Nineveh, presenting Al-Noor College's status through statistics. Following that, Prof. Dr. Aqeel Yahya Al-Arajee, the president of Al-Hamdaniya University, praised the position of Prof. Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar and Prof. Dr. Zuhair Al-Khashab for their academic journey towards obtaining their doctorates. He spoke about Al-Hamdaniya University's growth, resilience, and its steadfast commitment to serving the higher education sector. Subsequently, a twinning agreement was signed, and both the university and the college exchanged shields as tokens of their partnership. Participants then embarked on a visit to the college's halls and laboratories from there.

The signing ceremony of the agreement was attended by the Council of Al-Hamdaniya University and a number of heads of its scientific departments, as well as the Council of Al-Noor University College. The event was documented by the media of both institutions"







"The path of integration between higher education institutions in Nineveh Governorate. Al-Noor University College signed a twinning agreement with the Northern Technical University at noon on Monday, 27/01/2020. It was signed by Prof. Dr. Muwaffaq Yahya Hamdoun, President of the University, and signed by Prof. Dr. Yasin Taha Al-Hajjar, Dean of the College.

The signing ceremony, which took place in the meeting hall of the Al-Noor University College Council, began with special praise for the role of Prof. Dr. Muwaffaq Yahya Hamdoun in establishing the college and facilitating the requirements for its advancement and follow-up when he was head of the supervisory and qualitative evaluation apparatus in the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, then Prof. Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar spoke, illuminating the current reality of Al-Noor College, reviewing the stages of its establishment and growth. He also touched on the Northern Technical University, tracing the history of technical and artistic education until the emergence of the university, then Prof. Dr. Muwaffaq Yahya Hamdoun spoke about the colleges and institutes included in the Technical University in Mosul, Tikrit and elsewhere, stressing the desire to open institutes in the peripheries so that technical education reaches people in their areas of residence. After that, the two presidents of the university and the dean of the college exchanged the signing of the agreement, then they exchanged gifts to their institutions with a shield representing their respective institutions.


The signing ceremony was attended by the Council of the Northern Technical University and the Council of Al-Noor University . It was documented by the media teams of the two institutions."







Al-Noor University is keen to achieve direct rapprochement with higher education institutions, including government and private universities and colleges, to build and strengthen cooperation programs, exchange experiences, cross-fertilize the experiences of teaching staff, and improve students' capabilities. The college held a twinning agreement with the Middle Technical University, which was signed by its dean, Professor Dr. Yassin Taha. Al-Hajjar and signed by the Middle Technical University, its president, Prof. Dr. Wadhah Amer Hatem Yahya Al-Tamimi. The agreement stipulates academic cooperation, joint scientific research, activating visits between the two sides, quality management, academic evaluation, and conducting examinations in the joint colleges and departments.



As part of the ongoing efforts to enhance scientific cooperation between Al-Noor University and higher education institutions in Nineveh Governorate, a twinning and cooperation agreement was signed with Telafer University on Tuesday, 11/6/2024.

A high-level delegation from Telafer University, led by the university's president, Professor Dr. Abdulaziz Ahmed Aziz, visited Al-Noor University.

Before the signing of the agreement, a bilateral meeting was held in Al-Noor University Council Hall, during which both parties discussed their ideas on collaboration and areas where strengthening ties is needed. The final agreed-upon version of the twinning agreement was then presented and signed by Professor Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar on behalf of Al-Noor University and Professor Dr. Abdulaziz Ahmed Aziz on behalf of Telafer University.

Following the signing, the presidents of the two universities exchanged commemorative shields. The visit concluded with a tour for the Telafer University team to Al-Noor University's laboratories, examination committee, camera room, and several other university facilities.







As part of its efforts to expand cooperation with other universities and to achieve closer alignment with research and academic institutions, Al-Noor University hosted a delegation from Al-Manara University on the morning of Saturday, July 6, 2024. The delegation, led by Professor Dr. Faraj Mohammed Abdullah, President of Al-Manara University,

was received by Professor Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Al-Noor University. A comprehensive meeting took place at the university council, culminating in the signing of a bilateral cooperation agreement between the two universities, signed by their respective presidents. The visit concluded with a tour of Al-Noor University's facilities, allowing the guests to explore its colleges, departments, classrooms, laboratories, and medical and scientific units, including Al-Noor FM Radio and various medical laboratories and units.







The Third International Scientific Conference on the English Language, held under the theme of "AI and Technology in Languages, Humanities, Social Sciences, and Education," provided an excellent opportunity for a direct meeting between Prof. Dr. Yassin Taha AI-Hajjar, Dean of AI-Noor University College, and Prof. Dr. Habes Mohammad Khalifa, President of Jadara University in Jordan, along with the accompanying academic team. A thorough and insightful dialogue took place between the two parties, elucidating the convergence between the two academic institutions and laying the groundwork for an agreement, culminating in the signing of a bilateral cooperation agreement. The agreement, signed by Prof. Dr. Habes Mohammad Khalifa on the Jordanian side and Prof. Dr. Yassin Taha AI-Hajjar on the Iraqi side, stipulates cooperation in the field of academic programs of mutual interest, scientific consultations, and research. Additionally, it includes collaboration in relevant scientific activities such as conferences, seminars, and workshops, as well as cooperation in postgraduate studies through joint supervision and thesis discussions. Furthermore, it encompasses collaboration in consultancy, continuing education, exchange of faculty expertise, and reciprocal visits between the two universities for both faculty members and students.




"A bilateral agreement was organized and concluded between Al-Noor University College and AIMST Malaysia. A meeting was held on the global information network between the two academic institutions.
