1. Separator between road for vehicle and pedestrian path.
2. Ramps and guiding blocks which have suitable design for pedestrian having physical disabilities.
3. Street lamp for pedestrian in night. Alnoor University has 50 solar street lamps, which control the solar street lights automatically through the intensity of light.
4. The facility of lift is also provided in admin and academic block to facilitate students particularly with special needs. In Alnoor University We have 12 lifts in each building.
