In the presence of His Excellency the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, Dr. Naeem Al-Aboudi, along with his deputies and general directors of the ministry, Alnoor University participated in the week organized by the Iraqi Ministry of Higher Education. This event was dedicated to bringing together all Iraqi public and private universities with more than 100 Iranian universities as part of the ministry's initiative to establish international agreements and research collaborations with regional and global countries, aiming to enhance scientific openness between Iraqi universities and international institutions. The second edition of Science Week, held in Karbala, witnessed the signing of twinning agreements with Iranian universities. Representing Alnoor University were Prof. Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, the University President; Assistant Prof. Dr. Ismail Abdulwahab, Vice President for Academic Affairs; and Dr. Hani Muslim, Secretary of the University Council. It is worth noting that Alnoor University has a memorandum of understanding with the University of Kurdistan in Sanandaj and Razi University in Iran. Alnoor University achieved significant milestones, including inviting the University of Sanandaj and Razi University to attend the Third International Conference of the College of Education and to participate in the English Department's conference on artificial intelligence in humanities research. Faculty members from Islamic Azad University in Isfahan also attended Alnoor University's Second Sustainable Development Conference, while a representative from the Presidency of the University of Kurdistan in Sanandaj delivered an applied lecture on humanities and applications. Additionally, the University of Kurdistan in Sanandaj participated in the Artificial Intelligence Conference in Egypt as a supporting partner. In terms of collaborative research published in the Scopus database, Alnoor University has produced 60 joint studies with Islamic Azad University, 30 with Tehran University of Medical Sciences, 21 with Tehran University, 21 with Azad University of Tabriz, 13 with Kashan Medical University, 8 with Al-Tusi University, and 6 with Imam Reza University (peace be upon him).
