4 QUALITY EDUCATION



Access to education can enhance quality of life and prepare future leaders who will find solutions to global challenges. Providing education to children in technical, vocational, and entrepreneurial skills will serve as a foundation for sustainable development through scholarships and educational facilities, as well as eliminating gender disparities in access to education.

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In the presence of Prof. Dr. Osama Al-Mashhadani, President of the University of Nineveh; Prof. Dr. Aqeel Yahya Al-Araji, President of Al-Hamdaniya University; Prof. Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University; Prof. Dr. Munir Al-Badrani, Vice President of Mosul University for Scientific Affairs; the Turkish Consul General in Nineveh; Dr. Bashar Mahmoud, Chairman of the Board of Directors of Alnoor University; Prof. Dr. Basma Ahmed, representative of Al-Qabas University College; Mr. Mohannad Al-Jubouri; Ms. Somaya Al-Khabouri, members of the Nineveh Provincial Council; and the Vice Presidents of Alnoor University for Administrative and Scientific Affairs, along with several deans of colleges from universities in Nineveh Governorate, the activities of the Iraqi Universities Debate World Cup commenced at Alnoor University. This event, organized by the World Leadership and Development Organization in collaboration with the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, is hosted by Alnoor University in its second edition. Participants from eight public and private universities competed in the event. The tournament began with a speech by Prof. Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, followed by remarks from the tournament supervisor, Dr. Moaz Salem Abdulrahman. The World Cup Shield was then presented to Alnoor University by the tournament coordinator and received by the university president. A draw was conducted to allocate the participants into groups. Teams from Mosul University, Nineveh University, Northern Technical University, Al-Hamdaniya University, Tal Afar University, Alnoor University, Al-Hadba University, and Al-Qabas University College competed in the tournament. The competitions, judged by expert panels, concluded with the Alnoor University students' team emerging victorious, securing qualification for the Northern Region Universities Championship, which will also be hosted by Alnoor University. At the conclusion of the competitions, certificates were distributed to the judges, debating students, team supervisors, the organizational team of the World Leadership and Development Academy, the organizational team of Alnoor University, and the Media and Government Communication Department at Alnoor University.
