Quality Education

With the support of Alnoor University and in collaboration with the International Academy for Leadership and Development, the university hosted the Northern Region Universities Debate Championship. The event was attended by Professor Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University, Ms. Arivan Mahdi Haji, Member of the Nineveh Provincial Council, and Mar Benedictos Younan Hanno, Archbishop of the Syriac Catholic Archdiocese of Mosul and its surroundings. The competitions involved students from Alnoor University, Tikrit University, Kirkuk University, and Al-Maarif University. The event began with a welcoming speech by Professor Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University, followed by a speech delivered by Dr. Moath Salem Abdulrahman on behalf of the organizing entity. A video showcasing the modern developments at Alnoor University was presented, along with a video about the debates prepared by the International Academy for Leadership and Development. The competitions followed a knockout format. Teams from Alnoor University and Kirkuk University competed in one hall, while teams from Tikrit University and Al-Maarif University competed in another. The semifinals concluded with Kirkuk University and Tikrit University advancing to the final round, where Tikrit University's team claimed first place. They are now qualified to represent the Northern Region Universities in the Iraqi Universities Championship in Baghdad. At the conclusion of the event, certificates and shields were distributed to participants, including competitors, judges, administrators, supervisors, committee members, and university representatives.
