Moreover, global warming is causing long-term changes to our climate system, threatening irreversible consequences if we do not take necessary mitigation and adaptation actions today.

Climate Action

With the presence and participation of Professor Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University, the University's Diwan Affairs Department organized a new tree-planting campaign within the campus. A select group of students from various colleges and scientific departments, along with their faculty members, took part in the initiative. Additionally, the university's main nursery was reopened after its renovation and expansion. Dr. Nabil Ahmed Jargis, the Vice President for Administrative Affairs, also participated in the campaign. Previously, the university had conducted a large-scale tree-planting campaign, during which its academic and student community planted 1,000 seedlings along the central median extending from the university's main gate in the Al-Shallalat area towards the city entrance. The university has since adopted the practice of planting seedlings as a recurring tradition.
