

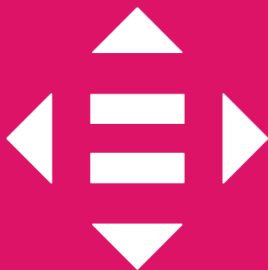


# Sustainable Development Goals



## Reduced Inequalities

### 10 REDUCED INEQUALITIES



Global inequality is increasing, with 1% of the world's population holding nearly half of the global wealth. Goal 10 of the Sustainable Development Goals aims to ensure equal opportunities by adopting legislation and following policies that improve living conditions for everyone in a sustainable manner. Special attention must be given to the most vulnerable countries, such as the least developed countries and small island developing states, particularly through directing financial flows to them.

## Reduced Inequalities

### College of Health and Medical Technologies

The Women's Affairs Unit at the College of Health and Medical Technologies at Alnoor University organized a seminar titled "Care and Protection of Working Women's Rights," based on the pillar of participation and institutional reform (Axis 4), emphasizing the importance of legal and administrative amendments aimed at ensuring women's rights in the workplace. The seminar was moderated by Dr. Walaa Abdul Wahid, Head of Women's Affairs at the university, and the lecture was delivered by Dr. Mona Taher Mohammed, a faculty member in the Medical Laboratory Technologies Department. During the seminar, Dr. Mona highlighted that the right to work is one of the most fundamental aspects of human life, as it is an essential need and an innate readiness tied to psychological well-being. She emphasized the importance of: Maternity protection and related rights, ensuring equality and non-discrimination based on gender and social status and providing a safe work environment free from harassment through necessary legal protections.
