Alnoor University inaugurated the activities of the Second International Conference on Sustainable Development Technologies, organized in collaboration with Al-Mustagbal University and the Northern Technical University, and held in the city of Alanya, Turkey, hosted by Alanya Alaaddin Keykubat University. The opening ceremony was attended by the Administrative Deputy Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, the Iraqi Cultural Attaché in Ankara, the Presidents of Al-Mustaqbal University and the Northern Technical University, and the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Alnoor University.
