### 16 PEACE, JUSTICE AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS



Encouraging the establishment of peaceful communities where no one is marginalized is essential for achieving sustainable development. This involves ensuring that everyone has access to justice, building effective and accountable institutions that are inclusive at all levels, and significantly reducing illicit flows of money and weapons. Additionally, it includes enhancing the recovery and return of stolen assets and combating all forms of organized crime..

In collaboration between the Department of Psychological Counseling and Educational Guidance at Alnoor University and the Counseling and Educational Guidance Unit at the Technical College of Computer Engineering and Artificial Intelligence – Northern Technical University, a scientific seminar was held under the title: “Cyberbullying and Its Negative Impact on Society.” The main lecture was delivered by Dr. Ahmed Saeed Rasheed, Director of the Department of Psychological Counseling and Educational Guidance at Alnoor University. In his presentation, he addressed the various forms and types of cyberbullying that affect individuals in society. During the discussion, emphasis was placed on the harms of cyberbullying and its psychological consequences, including how it can lead to frustration and loss of motivation among students. The seminar concluded with a set of recommendations aimed at raising awareness about the concept of cyberbullying and the importance of confronting it, reflecting the university’s commitment to fostering a healthy and safe educational environment.
