Al-Noor University signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the General Directorate of Education in Nineveh, in the presence of a number of academic and educational figures. The MoU was signed on behalf of Al-Noor University by Prof. Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, President of the University, and on behalf of the Directorate of Education by Mr. Mohammed Ibrahim Abboudi, Director General of Nineveh Education.

The memorandum includes several clauses aimed at serving the public interest and enhancing the quality of education. Key points include:
