## Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions

### 16 PEACE, JUSTICE AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS



Encouraging the establishment of peaceful communities where no one is marginalized is essential for achieving sustainable development. This involves ensuring that everyone has access to justice, building effective and accountable institutions that are inclusive at all levels, and significantly reducing illicit flows of money and weapons. Additionally, it includes enhancing the recovery and return of stolen assets and combating all forms of organized crime..

The annual Iraqi Youth Model United Nations (IYMUN) conference concluded at Alnoor University, with direct support from the university and the participation of international representatives from major universities such as the University of Oxford (UK), Sciences Po (France), and the University of Piraeus (Greece). The conference featured three main components:

- **Training Track:** Intensive sessions held at Alnoor University to equip youth with diplomatic skills and the drafting of resolution proposals.
- **Opening Ceremony:** Attended by official guests and prominently supported by Alnoor University, represented by its President, Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, and the Director of Cultural Relations, Dr. Mohammed Zuhair Zaidan.
- **Sessions Track:** Representatives of 68 countries took part in discussions on the topic: *"Combating Human Trafficking During Armed Conflicts"*. A draft resolution was voted on and subsequently submitted to the Human Rights Council in Geneva.
