The world today is more interconnected than ever before. Improving access to technology and knowledge is a crucial way to exchange ideas and foster innovation. Additionally, coordinating policies to help developing countries manage their debts, as well as encouraging investment in the least developed countries, is vital for achieving growth and sustainable development.

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As part of its openness to international universities and research centers and its efforts to strengthen academic cooperation in the field of cultural heritage preservation, a delegation from Alnoor University, headed by Dr. Nabil Nour Al-Din Hussein, Director of the Alnoor Center for Cultural Heritage Preservation, and accompanied by Dr. Omar Jassam, President of the Lamassu Organization for Culture, conducted a scientific visit to Dokuz Eylul University and Ege University in Izmir Province, Turkey. The visit included meetings with distinguished professors and scholars, among them Prof. Dr. Cumhuri Tanriver, Head of Excavations at the ancient city of Smyrna, and Prof. Dr. Duygu Akar from Dokuz Eylul University. Agreements were reached to launch joint projects in the areas of cultural heritage preservation and research exchange, in addition to the participation of the two Turkish universities in the Archaeological Tourism Conference that Alnoor University will organize on October 11–12. The visit also featured field tours of archaeological sites and the Izmir City Museum to explore Turkish experiences in heritage conservation. Dr. Nabil Nour Al-Din emphasized that this initiative is part of Alnoor University's strategy to strengthen its academic presence regionally and internationally, while advancing academic studies in archaeological tourism and the protection of cultural heritage.
