16 PEACE, JUSTICE AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS



Encouraging the establishment of peaceful communities where no one is marginalized is essential for achieving sustainable development. This involves ensuring that everyone has access to justice, building effective and accountable institutions that are inclusive at all levels, and significantly reducing illicit flows of money and weapons. Additionally, it includes enhancing the recovery and return of stolen assets and combating all forms of organized crime..

In a noble humanitarian gesture, Alnoor University organized a solidarity stand, marked by a minute of silence in remembrance of the genocide tragedy suffered by members of the Yazidi community. The event was attended by a number of faculty members, staff, and students, expressing sentiments of grief and solidarity with the victims and their families, and reaffirming the University's commitment to human values and justice.
