16 PEACE, JUSTICE AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS



Encouraging the establishment of peaceful communities where no one is marginalized is essential for achieving sustainable development. This involves ensuring that everyone has access to justice, building effective and accountable institutions that are inclusive at all levels, and significantly reducing illicit flows of money and weapons. Additionally, it includes enhancing the recovery and return of stolen assets and combating all forms of organized crime..

Under the patronage and in the presence of Prof. Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University, the University Presidency's Follow-up Department, in cooperation with the Nineveh Security Directorate through the Nineveh Universities and Institutes Security Center, organized an awareness seminar entitled "Your Card... Your Safety." The seminar was supervised by Talal Shukri Hiyas, Director of the Follow-up Department at the university, and delivered by a group of specialists from the Nineveh Security Directorate. Its themes focused on ways to protect MasterCard and Qi Card accounts from attempts of balance manipulation or unlawful exploitation by fraudsters, as well as the potential financial and legal consequences such actions may cause for cardholders. The seminar was attended by the deans of the Colleges of Education, Engineering, and Administrative Technologies, along with the President's Scientific Advisor and a number of heads of academic departments.
