## Partnerships For The Goals

A delegation from Alnoor University has resumed its visits to French universities as part of its efforts to enhance international cooperation and academic outreach. The delegation was headed by Professor Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, President of the University, and included Professor Dr. Ismail Abdulwahab Ismail, Assistant President for Scientific Affairs and Director of Cultural Relations, as well as Dr. Nabil Nooredin Hussein, Director of the Alnoor Center for Cultural Heritage Preservation. The delegation was hosted by the University of Lorraine in the city of Nancy, France. During the visit, the two parties agreed to launch joint cooperation programs in the fields of engineering, pharmacy, management, and economics, in addition to cultural heritage and archaeological tourism. The visit also featured the signing of a letter of intent for cooperation between the President of Alnoor University and the University of Lorraine, paving the way for the subsequent signing of a comprehensive framework cooperation agreement that will regulate scientific and cultural collaboration between the two institutions. The University of Lorraine (Université de Lorraine) is one of France's most prominent and prestigious universities, encompassing over 60,000 students and approximately 7,000 researchers and academics across 60 institutes and research laboratories. It is distinguished by its diverse academic specializations and its advanced standing in international rankings. This cooperation aligns with Alnoor University's strategy to enhance the quality of education and scientific research while fostering partnerships with global academic institutions, thereby creating broader opportunities for students and researchers.
