Partnerships For The Goals

In a qualitative step to enhance its international academic presence, a delegation from Alnoor University, headed by its President, Professor Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, visited Paris 1 Panthéon-Sorbonne University. The visit featured meetings with several leaders of the French university, resulting in an agreement to cooperate in student and faculty exchange, conference organization, and joint research publication. Additionally, opportunities were opened for Alnoor University students to pursue Master's degrees in English-taught programs in the fields of Law, Archaeology, Management, Economics, and Art History. Furthermore, the Institute of Art History commended Alnoor University's role in supporting the French archaeological mission working at the Khorsabad site and expressed its readiness to host students from the Department of Archaeological Tourism for field training. The institute emphasized the importance of the project to transform Khorsabad into a global tourist destination. The visit concluded with the signing of a Letter of Intent for scientific cooperation, paving the way for a comprehensive Memorandum of Understanding. This achievement adds to the series of steps Alnoor University is taking towards internationalization and enhancing its stature in academic forums.
