The first day also featured the opening research session, which included four distinguished scholarly papers, as follows: A joint paper titled *“The Impact of Technological Transformations of Artificial Intelligence and Virtual Reality on Military Media”* presented by Prof. Dr. Lubna Khamis Mahdi, Director General of the Research and Development Department at the Ministry of Higher Education, and Prof. Dr. Azraa Ismail Zidan, Head of the Capacity Building and Empowerment Department at the University of Baghdad. A paper titled *“A Journey in Media and Journalism: From Undergraduate Study to Doctoral Research”* by Dr. Bela Belagrova from Russia. A paper titled *“Digital Communication Technology and Artificial Intelligence in Enhancing and Developing Children’s Cognitive Skills”* by Dr. Abdulaziz Hameed Ali, faculty member at Alnoor University. A paper titled *“The Role of Media in Shaping Public Opinion and Political Decision-Making”* by Prof. Dr. Jasim Ahmed Khudair, Head of the Media Department at the College of Arts, University of Mosul. On the second day, the sessions were divided into two parallel tracks: The in-person session: Chaired by Prof. Dr. Jasim Mohammed Khudair, Head of the Media Department at the College of Arts, University of Mosul, which featured nine scholarly papers addressing contemporary media topics. The virtual session: Moderated by Dr. Bela Belagrova from Russia, during which fourteen research papers were presented by scholars from various Arab and international universities
