During the visit, the delegation met with university officials, where agreements were reached on the following:

- Allocating three postgraduate seats for top-ranking students from Alnoor University.
- Providing summer training opportunities for a group of Alnoor University students.
- Strengthening research collaboration between scientific centers at both universities.
- Hosting Koç University students at Alnoor University in archaeology and heritage tourism programs.
- Organizing joint cooperation between the College of Archaeology at Koç University and the Alnoor Center for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage.

This meeting comes as part of Alnoor University's commitment to building strong international academic partnerships that open broader horizons for its students and faculty in research, training, and development.
