1 NO POVERTY



Poverty is a condition attributed to individuals who are unable to meet their basic needs, which include all the essentials required for human survival and reflect the prevailing standard of living in society. Poverty impacts many aspects of life, leading to reduced levels of education, poor health, and inability to work. It also results in higher rates of vandalism and disorder within the community.

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Driven by its humanitarian mission and commitment to community service, Alnoor University has taken another meaningful step in its journey of social contribution through the implementation of the “My School” initiative, launched by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research to support orphaned and underprivileged students. The initiative was carried out through active collaboration between the College of Law and Political Science, the College of Engineering, and the Voluntary Work Unit at the university, and included a field visit to several schools across Nineveh Governorate. During the visit, the university distributed 150 fully equipped school bags containing essential educational materials and stationery to orphaned and needy schoolgirls — an initiative that reflects Alnoor University’s deep commitment to supporting education and promoting a spirit of solidarity and compassion within the community. Through this humanitarian approach, Alnoor University reaffirms that its mission extends beyond education itself — reaching beyond the university walls to touch people’s lives and plant hope in their hearts, embodying its vision of being a university for knowledge and humanity alike.
