## Partnerships For The Goals

An online meeting was held via Zoom between representatives of Alnoor University (Iraq) and Paris 8 University (France) to discuss prospects and pathways for academic and scientific cooperation between the two institutions. Representing Alnoor University were Professor Dr. Ismail Abdulwahab Ismail, Assistant President of the University for Scientific Affairs; Assistant Professor Dr. Mohammed Zuhair Zidan, Director of Cultural Relations; Dr. Nabil Nour Al-Din Hussein, Director of Alnoor Center for the Preservation of Cultural Heritage; and Dr. Rasheed Mahmoud Youssef, Director of the Quality Assurance Department. The joint meeting explored mechanisms to strengthen academic collaboration through student, faculty, and researcher exchange programs, as well as supporting research centers at Alnoor University—particularly the Linguistics Center and the Center for Continuing Education. Special attention was given to the project of establishing a Legal Clinic at the College of Law at Alnoor University, in collaboration with its counterpart at Paris 8 University. Notably, this concept was first introduced by the College of Law at Paris 8 and has since spread to many universities worldwide. In this context, Alnoor University had previously hosted Professor Sophie Mollinier from Paris 8 University, who delivered a specialized lecture on the French experience in this field. At the conclusion of the meeting, both parties reaffirmed their commitment to developing short-, medium-, and long-term programs of academic and cultural cooperation, with a particular focus on the fields of law, languages, digital media, and artificial intelligence technologies.
