### 16 PEACE, JUSTICE AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS



Encouraging the establishment of peaceful communities where no one is marginalized is essential for achieving sustainable development. This involves ensuring that everyone has access to justice, building effective and accountable institutions that are inclusive at all levels, and significantly reducing illicit flows of money and weapons. Additionally, it includes enhancing the recovery and return of stolen assets and combating all forms of organized crime..

### College of Law

As part of a series of awareness activities and sessions provided for groups receiving care from the Ministry of Migration and Displacement at the Al-Amal Center for Psychological and Community Rehabilitation, and based on joint coordination between the Migration and Displacement Directorate – Nineveh Branch, the Nineveh Court of Appeal, University of Mosul, Alnoor University, and the Directorate for Combating Intellectual Terrorism, a special awareness session was held for the team supporting families at Al-Amal Center. During the session, the Intellectual Extremism Combat Team delivered a specialized lecture presented by Assistant Professor Dr. Ahmed Mustafa Ali, Dean of the College of Law and Political Science at Alnoor University. The lecture witnessed wide interaction and valuable contributions from attendees, including staff from the Migration and Displacement Directorate. Participants expressed their opinions and inquiries regarding the topics discussed, focusing on mechanisms to combat intellectual extremism and ways to promote social integration. This activity is part of a series of rehabilitation seminars and awareness sessions organized at Al-Amal Center, aiming to intellectually, psychologically, socially, and religiously rehabilitate families, ensuring their safe integration into society and equipping them with educational skills and knowledge that contribute to peaceful coexistence and prevent future social gaps.
