College of Law

In the presence of Mr. Ali Omar, Deputy Governor of Nineveh, and Dr. Ahmed Mustafa, Dean of the College of Law and Political Science at Alnoor University, the university's Human Rights Division organized an awareness seminar entitled *"The National Strategy to Combat Human Trafficking."* Supervised by Assistant Lecturer Qaidar Ahmed Mahmoud, the seminar included several specialists and researchers and was divided into three main sessions: Mr. Ali Omar discussed the role of Nineveh Governorate in combating human trafficking and the measures taken to address it; Dr. Shaimaa Jafar examined the role of the Survivors' Law in protecting and supporting victims; and Dr. Amer Al-Hadi explained relevant international legislation, including global legal frameworks and treaties against this transnational crime. The seminar concluded with an interactive discussion highlighting the importance of raising community awareness, activating legal frameworks, protecting human rights, and enhancing societal security. This event reflects Alnoor University's commitment to fostering a culture of human rights and promoting legal awareness within both the academic community and the local environment.
