4 QUALITY EDUCATION



Access to education can enhance quality of life and prepare future leaders who will find solutions to global challenges. Providing education to children in technical, vocational, and entrepreneurial skills will serve as a foundation for sustainable development through scholarships and educational facilities, as well as eliminating gender disparities in access to education.

The First International Forum for Continuing Education Centers in Iraqi Universities was launched, organized by the Northern Technical University under the patronage of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and supported by Alnoor University, under the theme: *“Continuing Education: Renewed Horizons for Leading and Sustainable Iraqi Universities.”* The forum began with a speech by the representative of the Ministry of Higher Education, followed by a speech from Prof. Dr. Alia Abbas Al-Attar, President of the Northern Technical University. Prof. Dr. Ismail Abdulwahab, Vice President of Alnoor University for Scientific Affairs, delivered a speech on behalf of the supporting institutions, emphasizing the importance of continuing education in improving the performance of Iraqi universities and enhancing their role in serving the community and developing academic and professional skills. The forum included the presentation of seven scientific papers followed by an interactive discussion session, concluding with a set of recommendations and the distribution of appreciation certificates to participants. Prof. Dr. Munir Al-Badrani, Scientific Advisor at Alnoor University, also took part in the forum alongside a distinguished group of academics and researchers from various Iraqi universities—reflecting Alnoor University’s commitment to supporting scientific initiatives that contribute to the development of continuing education and strengthening the efficiency of academic institutions in Iraq.
