16 PEACE, JUSTICE AND STRONG INSTITUTIONS



Encouraging the establishment of peaceful communities where no one is marginalized is essential for achieving sustainable development. This involves ensuring that everyone has access to justice, building effective and accountable institutions that are inclusive at all levels, and significantly reducing illicit flows of money and weapons. Additionally, it includes enhancing the recovery and return of stolen assets and combating all forms of organized crime..

Alnoor University organized a workshop titled “Cyber Awareness in the University Environment”, attended by Prof. Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, President of the University, and Prof. Dr. Ismail Abdulwahab, the Scientific Assistant to the President, with the participation of a distinguished group from the Digital Team of the Council of Ministers. The workshop was organized by the Career Development and Employment Division at the university presidency, in collaboration with the Department of Medical Laboratory Techniques at the College of Health and Medical Technologies. It was presented by Ahmed Mohammed Suleiman, a fourth-year student in the department, who discussed key concepts of cybersecurity, methods of hacking and digital fraud, and the most effective protection and prevention strategies amid the rapid pace of digital transformation. The workshop aimed to enhance digital security awareness among students and faculty members and to promote a culture of safe use of modern technologies within the university, in line with Al-Noor University’s vision of building a safe and sustainable digital academic environment.
