The world today is more interconnected than ever before. Improving access to technology and knowledge is a crucial way to exchange ideas and foster innovation. Additionally, coordinating policies to help developing countries manage their debts, as well as encouraging investment in the least developed countries, is vital for achieving growth and sustainable development.

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An intellectual workshop was held at the Franco–Iraqi Cultural Institute under the supervision of Professor Dr. Mohammed Basil Al-Azzawi, Director of the Linguistics Center at Alnoor University, entitled *“Lawrence of Arabia and Charles de Foucauld: Myth and Reality in the Arab Mashreq and Maghreb.”* The workshop was presented by Assistant Professor Dr. Haseeb Elias Hadid and Assistant Professor Dr. Mohammed Zuhair Zidan, faculty members of the Department of Translation at the College of Arts, Alnoor University, who offered a critical analysis of the mythological and historical dimensions of the figures of Lawrence of Arabia and Charles de Foucauld, highlighting their influence on Orientalist discourse and within the cultural and political contexts of both the Arab Mashreq and Maghreb. The workshop was attended by the French Consul in Mosul, Mr. Fabrice Debelshon, along with a distinguished group of academics, researchers, and those interested in intellectual and cultural affairs, who enriched the session with valuable scholarly discussions and interventions. The workshop concluded with an emphasis on the importance of organizing such academic activities in fostering academic and critical dialogue and opening new intellectual horizons for understanding history and its reciprocal cultural representations between East and West.
