The seminar was supervised by Lecturer Dr. Karam Muzaffar Jassim, a faculty member of the department, and featured contributions from several specialists. Assistant Lecturer Ali Osama Al-Rifa’i from the Sunni Endowment Directorate presented a paper addressing the religious perspective in confronting addiction, while Lecturer Dr. Raed Suleiman Mohammed from the Ministry of Health delivered a lecture on the harmful health effects of addiction. In addition, Colonel Hazem from the Community Police highlighted the security dimension of combating addiction and the role of security institutions in awareness and treatment. The seminar witnessed notable attendance from faculty members and students and included discussions and questions that enriched its themes, contributing to raising awareness of the importance of employing digital space in a positive manner and limiting its risks, particularly those related to addiction and its various repercussions.
