College of Law

In the presence of Professor Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University, the Legal Clinic and Continuing Education Unit at the College of Law and Political Science organized a specialized educational session addressing the practical provisions of the Civil Procedure Law and litigation procedures before the courts. The session was supervised by Dr. Mohammed Saeed Al-Rahu and Dr. Fares Ahmed Al-Dulaimi, faculty members of the college, while the lecture was delivered by Judge Maad Abdulwahab, who reviewed key practical challenges in the application of the law and explained litigation mechanisms in accordance with established legal frameworks, presenting examples of cases and procedures followed in Iraqi courts. The session was attended by Professor Dr. Ismail Abdulwahab, Scientific Assistant to the University President, along with the Dean of the College of Education, the Dean of the College of Law and Political Science, and the Scientific Advisor. This session forms part of the college's programs aimed at enhancing students' legal knowledge and linking theoretical concepts with practical application within the judicial environment.
