4 QUALITY EDUCATION



Access to education can enhance quality of life and prepare future leaders who will find solutions to global challenges. Providing education to children in technical, vocational, and entrepreneurial skills will serve as a foundation for sustainable development through scholarships and educational facilities, as well as eliminating gender disparities in access to education.

In the presence of Professor Dr. Alyaa Al-Attar, President of the Northern Technical University, and in cooperation with Al-Khaleej College and the International Institute for Training and Institutional Development (iiTiD), the training program entitled “*Preparing a Certified Trainer in Soft Skills Development for Faculty Members, Teachers, Trainers, and Academic Professionals*” was launched in Nineveh Governorate. The workshop witnessed wide academic and institutional participation, with Professor Dr. Ismail Abdulwahab Ismail, Assistant President of Alnoor University for Scientific Affairs, taking part as the university’s representative, reaffirming its commitment to supporting professional development programs and strengthening scientific partnerships that contribute to improving the quality of education and building the capacities of teaching staff. The workshop outcomes covered several themes, including developing communication skills and educational leadership, enhancing critical thinking, activating feedback tools to improve academic performance, employing soft skills in blended learning, empowering students to express themselves and develop their skills, and adopting academic practices in line with quality assurance and accreditation standards. The program also included the awarding of participation certificates and professional accreditation to participants in accordance with the organizing and accrediting bodies.
