The First International Educational Forum was held at Alnoor University in cooperation between the College of Education at the university and the Open Educational College at the General Directorate of Education in Nineveh. The forum opened with speeches by Professor Dr. Yassin Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University, Dr. Abeer Mufakir Al-Sheikh Ali, Director of the Open Educational College, and Professor Dr. Khazal Fathi Zaidan, Dean of the College of Education, followed by the opening lecture delivered by Professor Dr. Munir Salem Al-Badrani, the University's Scientific Advisor, entitled "Education for Generations Z and Alpha." The opening session concluded with the distribution of shields and certificates to the officials and researchers participating in the forum. The forum then continued with a scientific research session chaired by Assistant Professor Dr. Qais Omar, with Assistant Teacher Asmaa Khalil Ibrahim serving as rapporteur, during which six research papers were presented by Dr. Ahmed Yaqdan Saleh, Dr. Ahmed Mohammed Yahya, Assistant Teachers Raafat Najeeb Ftouhi, Mohammed Abdul-Basit, Mohammed Abdullah, and Ru'a Fares Mohammed, addressing various educational and scientific themes that contribute to the development of the educational and research process. The session concluded with a series of academic comments and interventions that enriched the discussion, after which the First International Educational Forum was brought to a close amid praise for the quality of the research papers, participation, and organization.
