4 QUALITY EDUCATION



Access to education can enhance quality of life and prepare future leaders who will find solutions to global challenges. Providing education to children in technical, vocational, and entrepreneurial skills will serve as a foundation for sustainable development through scholarships and educational facilities, as well as eliminating gender disparities in access to education.

Alnoor University participated in a workshop on European Union Erasmus+ grant programs for funding research projects, titled *Capacity Building in Higher Education*, organized by the Department of Scholarships and Cultural Relations – Erasmus+ Programs Unit at the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, and hosted by the University of Mosul at the Scientific and Literary Forum. The workshop lasted for three days and addressed the mechanisms for applying to Erasmus+ grants, their conditions, and the various academic exchange and mobility programs, in addition to expanding international partnerships and developing joint projects aimed at building the capacities of students and academic staff within higher education institutions. Alnoor University was represented by the Director of the Cultural Relations Department, the Erasmus+ Unit Officer, and a number of academic researchers from the university, reflecting the university's commitment to expanding its international cooperation network and benefiting from the funding and exchange opportunities provided by the European Union to enhance education and scientific research.
