Alnoor University announced the allocation of fully funded scholarships for orphaned and underprivileged students registered in the “Khalooha Ajmal” initiative, in a humanitarian step that reflects the university’s commitment to its social responsibility and its continuous support for the people of Mosul. This initiative followed a meeting between the Khalooha Ajmal Foundation and the Chairman of Alnoor University’s Board of Trustees, Dr. Bashar Mahmoud Ali, during which it was agreed to provide full scholarships covering all tuition fees for four consecutive years. The initiative aims to empower disadvantaged and orphaned students to continue their university education and broaden their future opportunities, contributing to the development of an educated generation capable of serving society and participating in the revival of Mosul. The university emphasized that this initiative is part of its ongoing programs to support humanitarian and developmental efforts, based on its belief that education is the most important path toward building a better future for society.
