Alnoor University in a brief

Established in 2013 in the heart of Nineveh, Alnoor University began as Al-Noor University College, with four departments in the humanities. Through years of development, the university has witnessed remarkable growth by establishing new academic departments. The university achieved a significant milestone by obtaining approval from the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research to become the first private university in Nineveh, carrying forward the legacy of public universities. Overcoming numerous challenges, it has emerged as a distinguished academic institution. The university comprises ten colleges across various disciplines, including medical, health, technical, engineering, administrative, and humanities, with 26 academic departments, some of which are unique at the local, national, or regional levels. The university provides students with suitable classrooms and advanced laboratories, in addition to dental teaching clinics equipped with 115 dental chairs, which serve over 250 patients daily, free of charge. It contributes to heritage preservation and research through its Department of Archaeological Tourism and the Alnoor Center for Heritage Preservation, while demonstrating its environmental commitment through the utilization of solar energy, medical waste incinerators, recycling devices, and afforestation initiatives. In scientific research, the university's faculty has published over 1,315 Scopus-indexed papers, including more than 400 in Q1 journals, 91 in the top 10% of global publications, and 885 papers in the Web of Science. International collaboration with foreign researchers has reached 70%, and the university has entered 12 international rankings, with eight of its departments ranking among Iraq's top ten. Alnoor University publishes seven peer-reviewed scientific journals and organizes specialized international conferences, both within and outside Iraq (over 35 conferences), in addition to 150 workshops and seminars during the 2024-2025 academic year. It has also initiated graduate programs in cooperation with Malaysia's UTP University. The university welcomes Arab and international students and faculty, offering annual free scholarships for students in each department through its "Study in Iraq" initiative. With this academic diversity, rigorous scientific research, and international outreach, An-Noor University has become a new spring flourishing in the land of Nineveh.

No Poverty

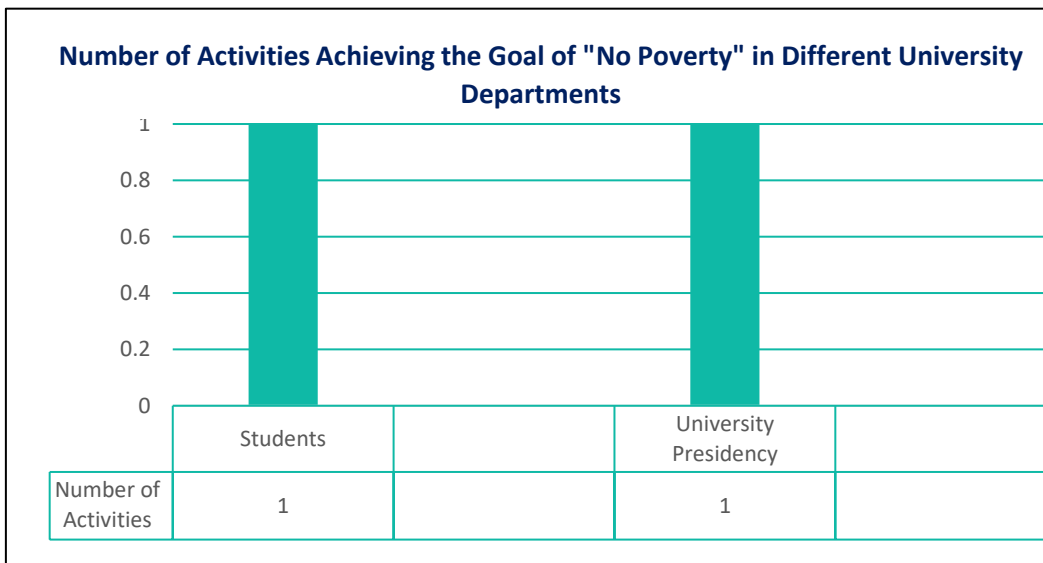

Zero Hunger

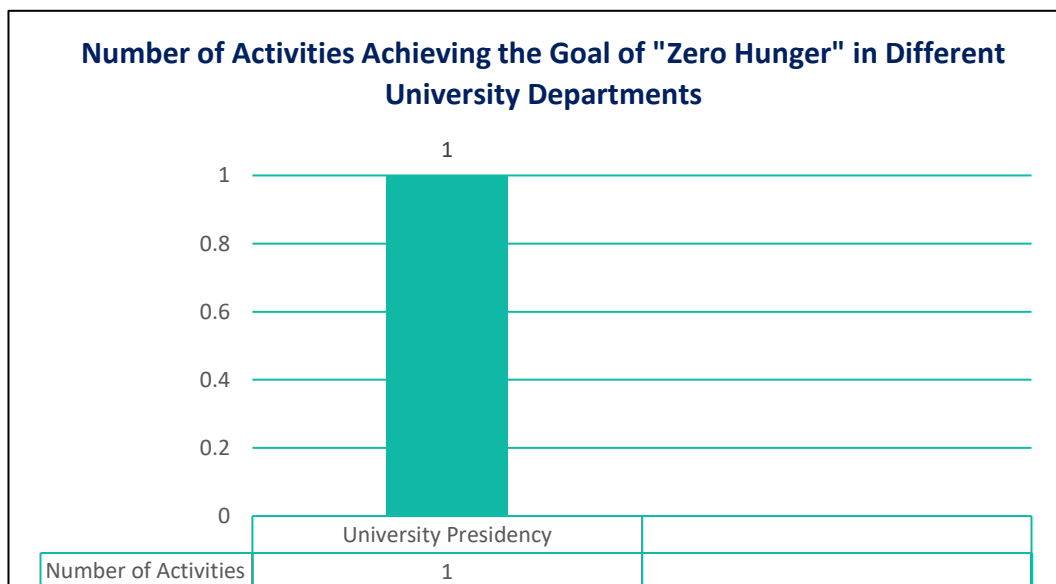

Clean Water and Sanitation

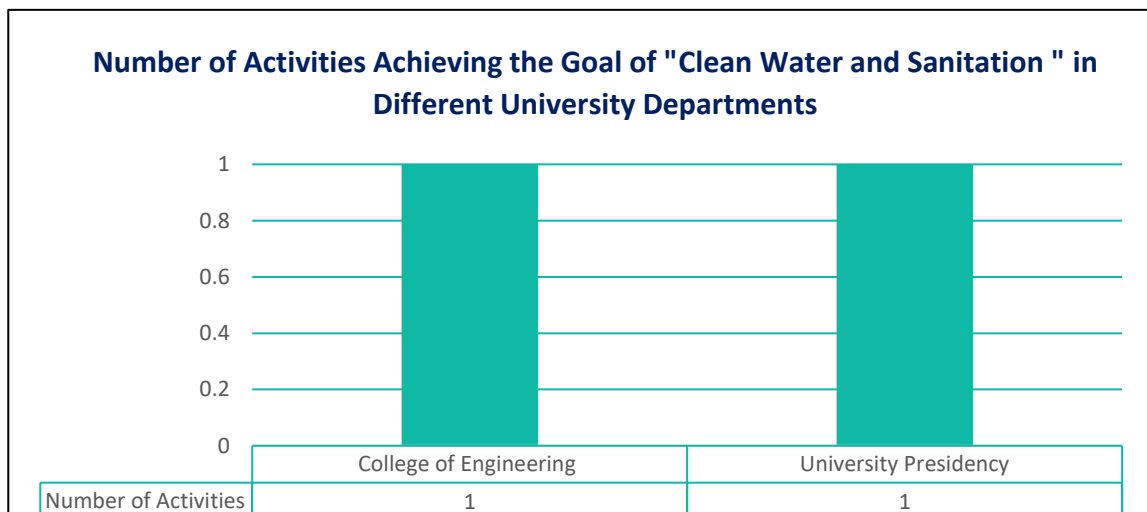

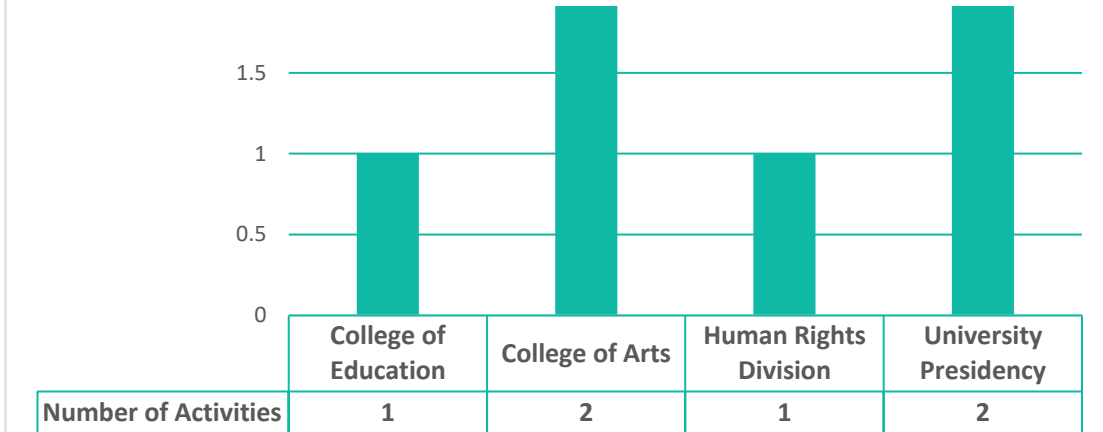
The Digital Media Department at Alnoor University, in coordination with the Continuing Education Department, organized a training workshop on the uses of artificial intelligence in digital media.

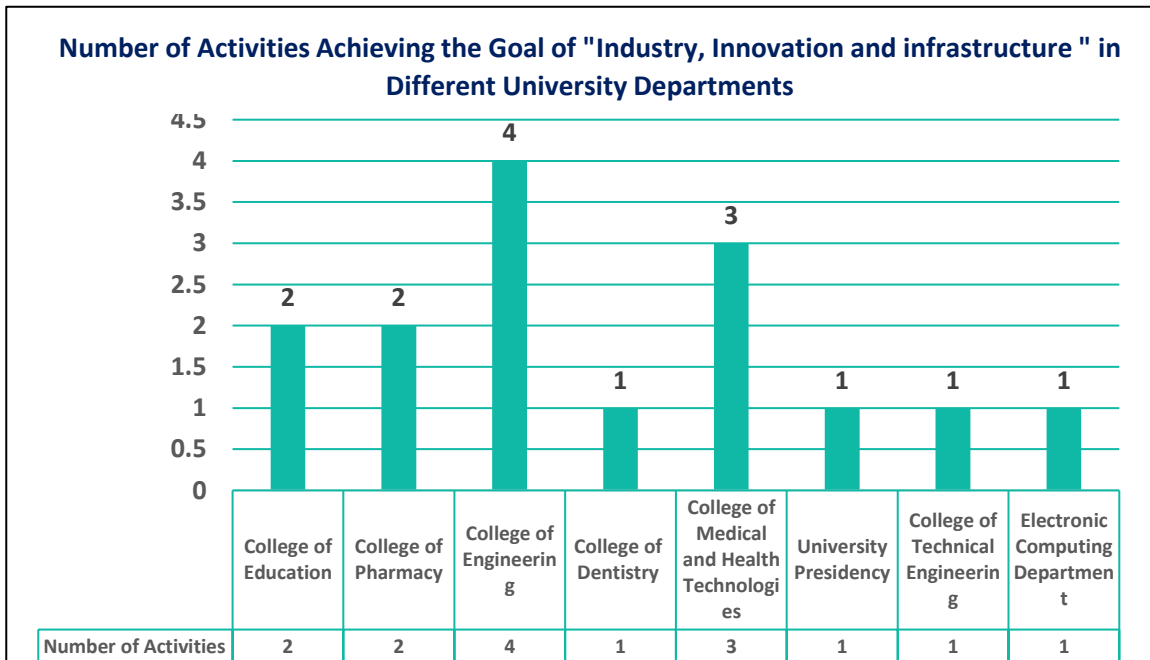

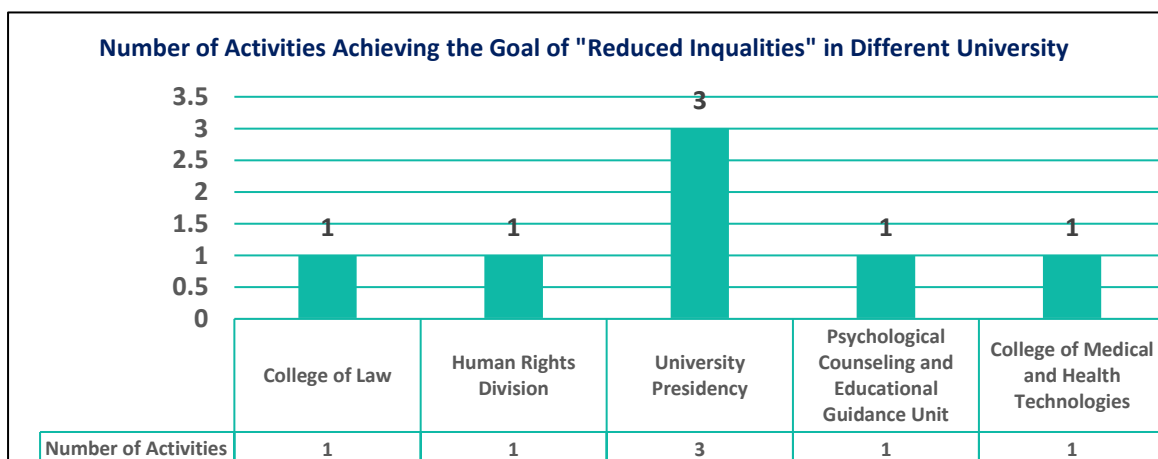

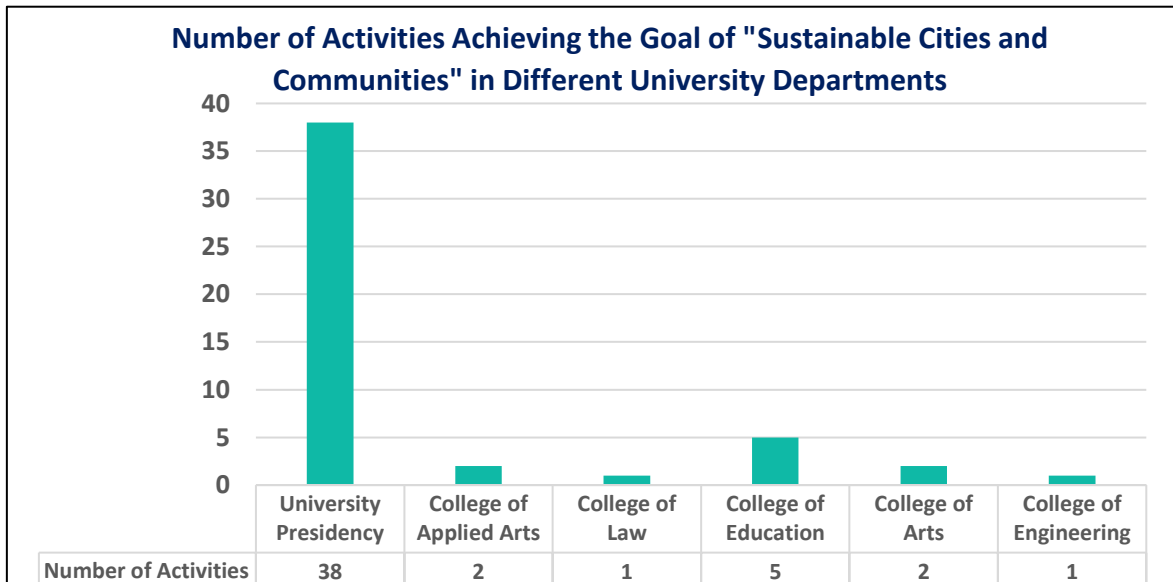

Responsible Consumption and Production

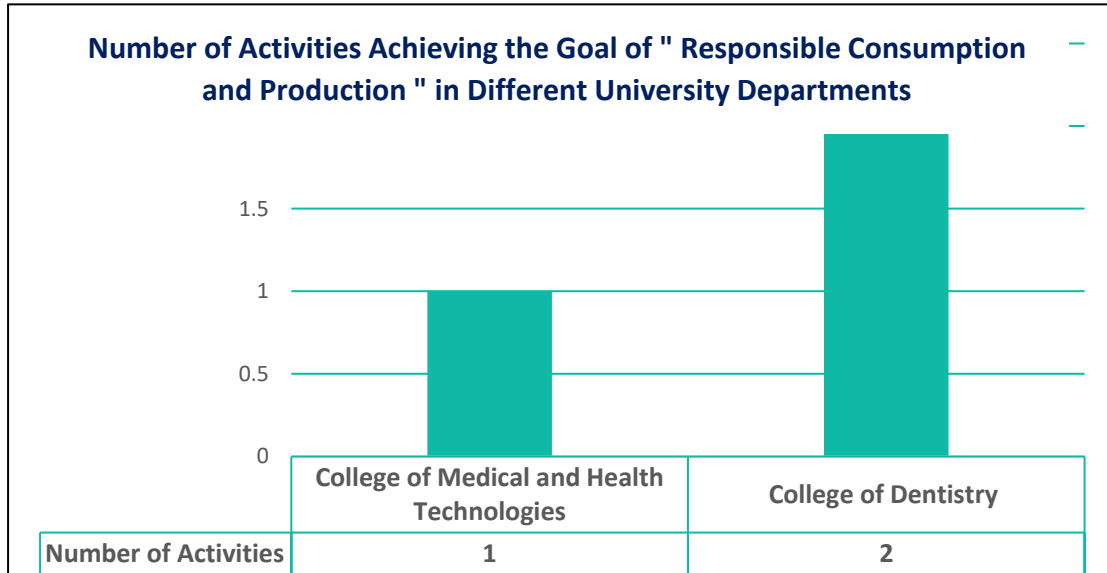

The University organized a major afforestation campaign in Nineveh Governorate under the slogan "A Tree for Every Citizen".

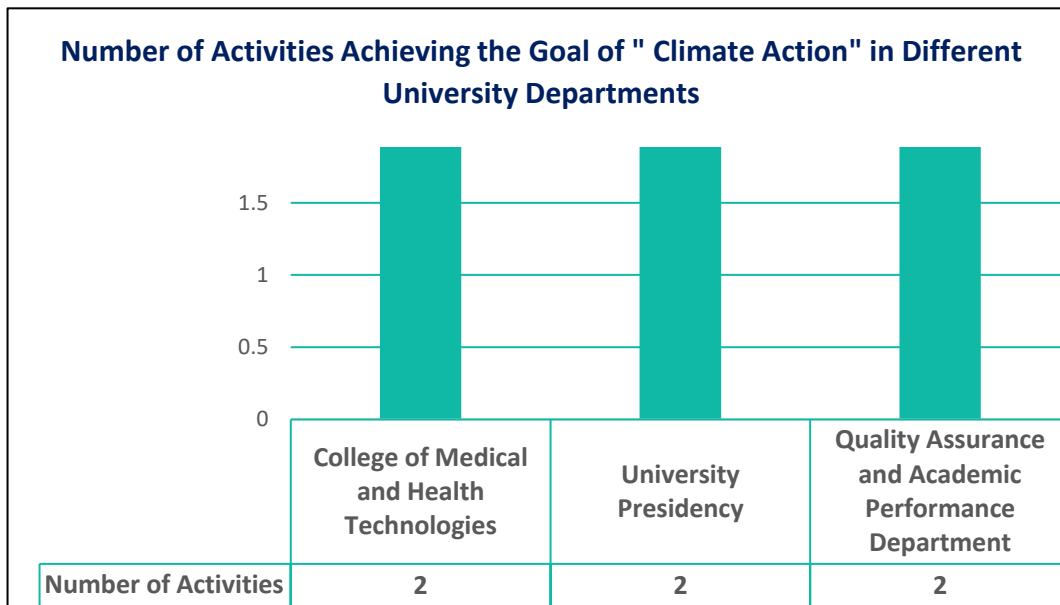

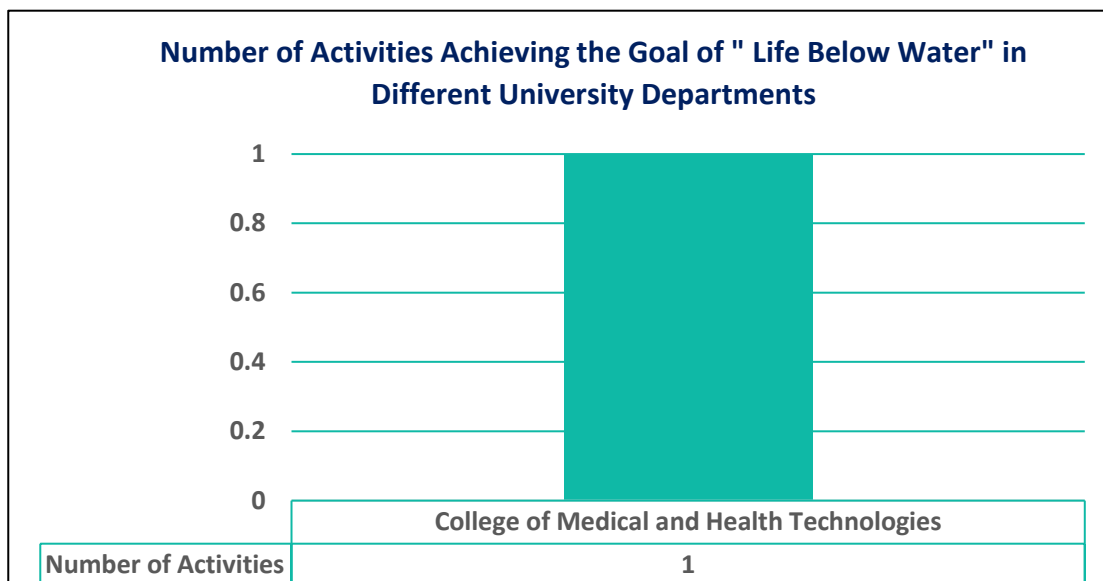

Life On Land

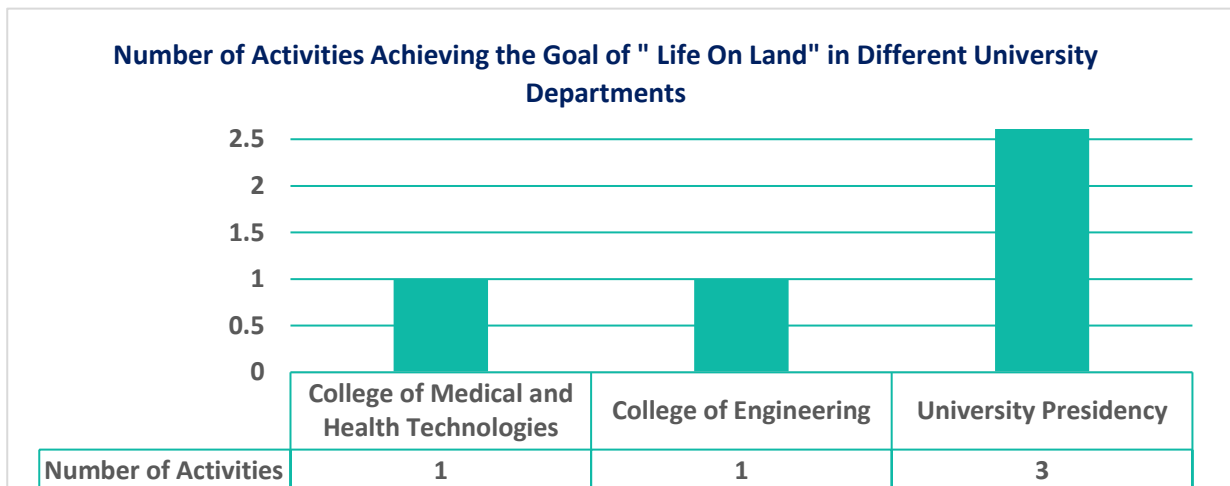

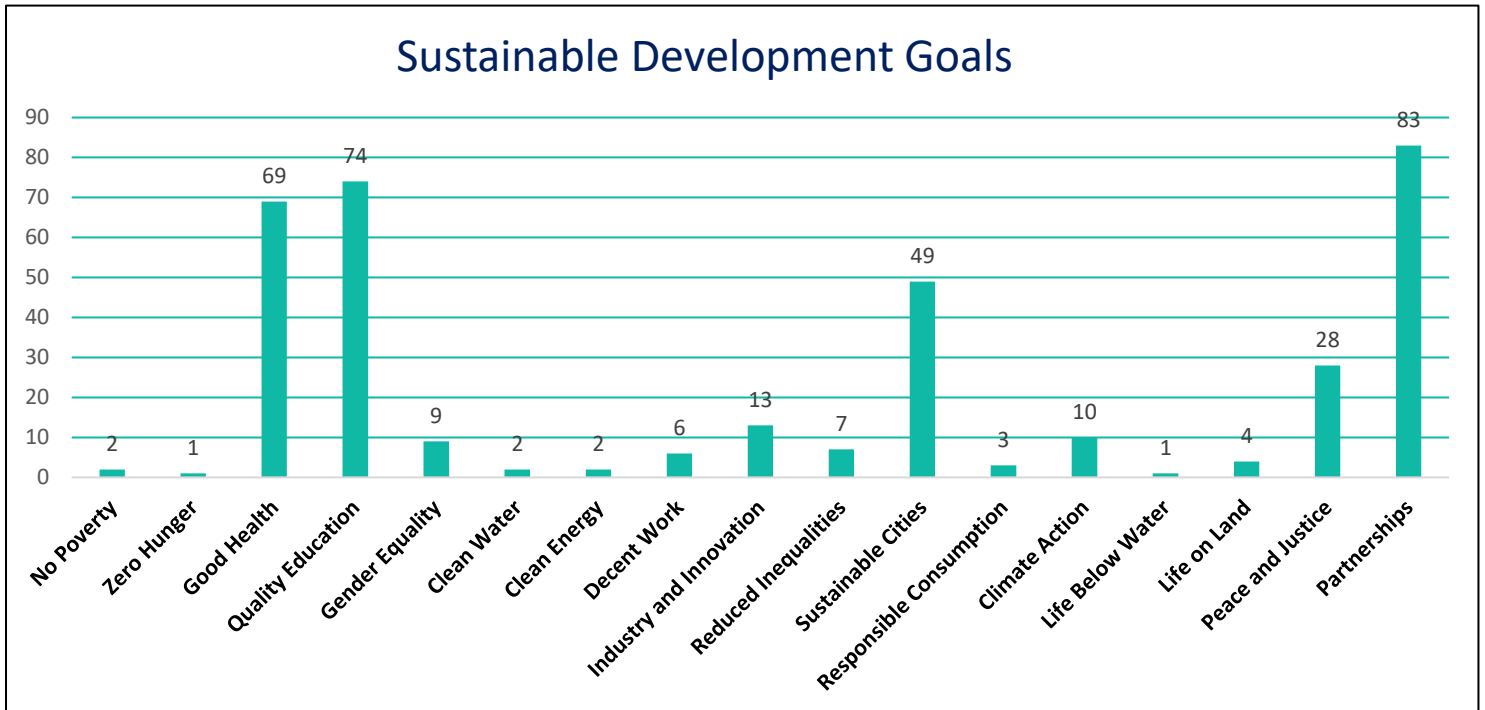
**Number of Activities Achieving the Goal of "Partnerships for The Goals " in
