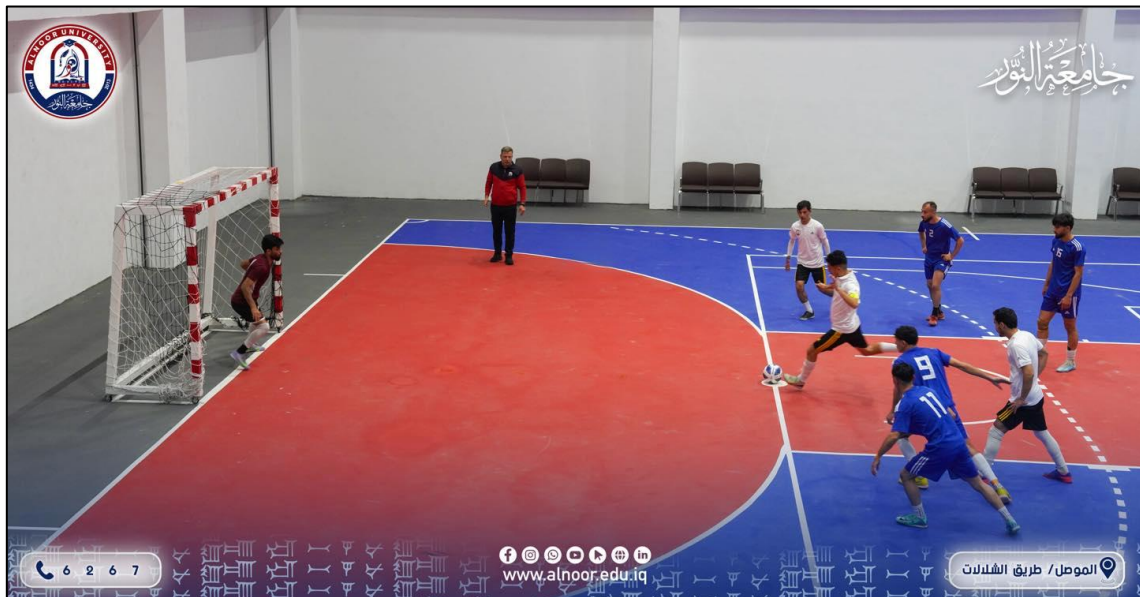

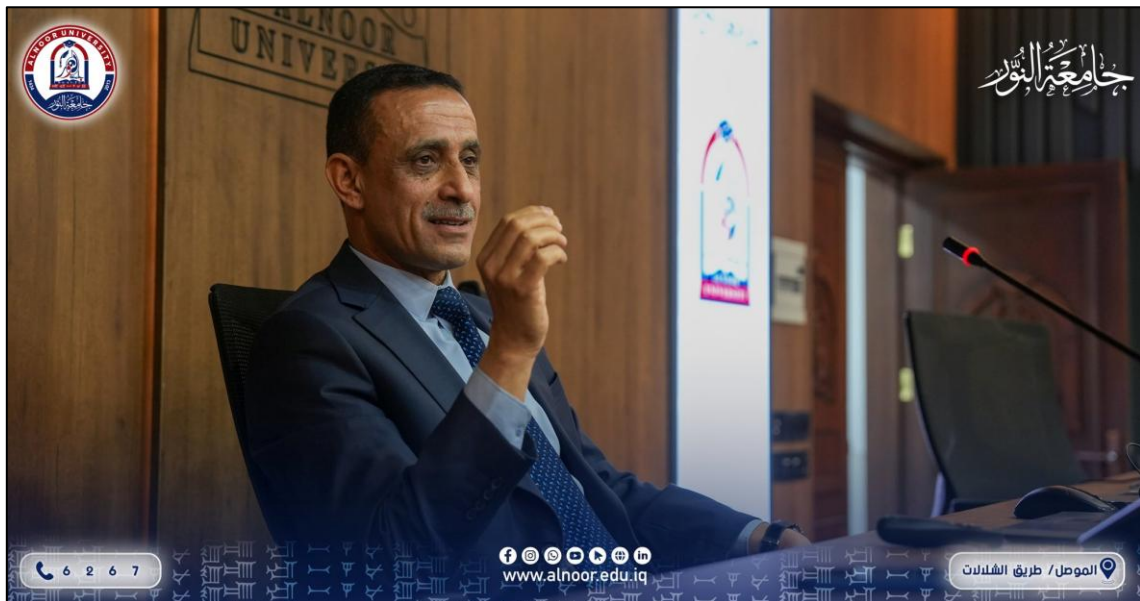
College of Health and Medical Technologies

The Department of Medical Laboratory Techniques at the College of Health and Medical Technologies, Alnoor University, organized a scientific workshop titled “The Effect of Radiation on Microorganisms,” delivered by Assistant Professor Dr. Mona Taher Al-Naftchi. The workshop introduced the different types of radiation and their various effects on microorganisms, highlighting the mechanisms by which radiation impacts microscopic cells, including inducing mutations, inhibiting growth, or eliminating microorganisms. It also addressed the practical applications of radiation in medical sterilization and preservation processes, in addition to outlining potential risks and methods of protection.



College of Education

The Department of Chemistry at the College of Education, Alnoor University, organized a scientific workshop titled “Chemical and Biological Hazards in Scientific Laboratories,” supervised and managed by Professor Dr. Diao Najm Al-Subha. The workshop featured contributions from Assistant Professor Dr. Marwan Mohammed Abdullah Al-Sharouk, Assistant Professor Dr. Mohammed Abdulhadi Jassim, and Lecturer Dr. Reem Nawaf Hamdoon. It addressed multiple topics related to the safe handling of chemical substances and biological agents within laboratories, as well as introducing safety procedures and methods for preventing potential hazards. The workshop aimed to raise awareness among students and researchers about the importance of adhering to occupational safety guidelines, thereby contributing to the creation of a safe and supportive laboratory environment for scientific work.



College of Health and Medical Technologies

The Department of Medical Laboratory Techniques at the College of Health and Medical Technologies at Alnoor University, in cooperation with the Continuing Education Center, organized an awareness lecture on dog bites and rabies. The lecture was delivered by Assistant Lecturer Haneen Mahmoud Rashid, who provided an introduction to dog bites, first aid measures, and transmitted diseases, as well as an overview of rabies, its symptoms, its spread in Iraq, and methods of prevention and vaccination.
