### 4 QUALITY EDUCATION



Access to education can enhance quality of life and prepare future leaders who will find solutions to global challenges. ## Quality Education

### College of Law and Political Science

The Department of Law at the College of Law and Political Science at Alnoor University witnessed the discussion of graduation research projects for fourth-year students for the academic year (2025–2026), held in the Moot Court Hall. A system was adopted in which two students collaborated on preparing a single research project, enhancing the spirit of cooperation and teamwork. A total of 119 students from both morning and evening studies participated in the discussions, which were conducted over two consecutive days, Saturday and Sunday, April 4 and 5, in a rigorous academic atmosphere under the careful supervision of specialized committees. The presented research covered a variety of legal and political topics, reflecting an advanced academic level and the significant efforts made by students under the guidance of their professors, contributing to the enrichment of society with distinguished academic outputs. At the conclusion of the discussions, the scientific committees commended the good quality of the submitted research.

### College of Engineering

The Department of Unmanned Aircraft Systems Engineering at the College of Engineering, Alnoor University, organized a scientific seminar entitled “Ethics of Engineering Professions” on Monday, in the presence of Professor Dr. Saad Al-Ta’an, Dean of the College, who actively participated by delivering a lecture. The seminar, presented by Assistant Lecturer Saad Saleh Diab, addressed the key ethical principles that engineers should uphold throughout their professional careers, including commitment to professional responsibility, adherence to safety standards, preservation of academic integrity, and the importance of making professional decisions that serve the public interest.

### College of Arts

In its first academic activity, and in the presence of Dr. Wael Al-Nahas, Dean of the College of Arts at Alnoor University, the Department of Clinical Psychology, in cooperation with the Continuing Education Center at the university, organized a workshop entitled “Readings in Clinical Psychology.” The workshop was supervised by Assistant Professor Dr. Asmaa Ghanem Hussein, Head of the Department, and aimed to assess the students’ benefit from reading the book *Clinical Psychology* and their level of understanding, as well as to enhance their ability to argue, express comprehension, and demonstrate proficiency in this scientific field. This was achieved through discussions conducted before a committee of female faculty members from the department, including Assistant Lecturers Saja Bilal Jassim and Ghufra Hassan Mohsen, in addition to the Head of the Department.

The results of the competition were then announced, and medals and certificates were awarded to the winning team, the participating debaters, and the judging committees.

### Engineering Technical College

Under the supervision of Professor Dr. Kamil Ali Abdulmohsen, Dean of the Engineering Technical College at Alnoor University, the Department of Artificial Intelligence Engineering organized a scientific seminar entitled “Robotics Machine Vision.” The seminar featured two lectures delivered by Professor Dr. Mazen Rajab Khalil, Head of the Department, and Assistant Lecturer Ahmed Jamal Mohammed, a faculty member in the department. The seminar addressed key topics in the field of machine vision and robotic systems, highlighting the latest technologies and applications used in this area, contributing to the development of students’ skills and keeping pace with scientific and technological advancements. The event witnessed notable engagement from attending students, who raised numerous questions and contributions that enriched the scientific discussion and achieved the intended benefits.

In cooperation between Alnoor University and Al-Hamdaniya University, the activities of the Second Annual Scientific Sports Conference were launched at Alnoor University in the presence of Professor Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University, and Professor Dr. Nashat Mubarak, President of Al-Hamdaniya University. Held over two days, the conference focused on sports sciences and physical education and their role in quality of life and sports sustainability. A panel discussion was conducted and moderated by Professor Dr. Nazim Shaker, Head of the Department of Physical Education and Sports Sciences at Alnoor University, featuring contributions from Professor Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar and Assistant Professor Mohammed Yaqdhan, who discussed the newly published book by Dr. Al-Hajjar entitled “Comprehensive Specialized Sports Training from a Physiological Perspective.” The conference also included sessions presenting a number of rigorous scientific research papers that emphasized enhancing individual and community health and highlighted the importance of physical activity in improving quality of life, alongside the need to develop academic curricula in line with global advancements in the sports sector. At the conclusion of the conference, emphasis was placed on the importance of continuing such high-quality scientific events, supporting applied research, promoting sports psychology, and spreading a culture of sustainability to serve society and achieve sustainable development.

In the presence of Professor Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University, and Professor Dr. Nashat Mubarak, President of Al-Hamdaniya University, Alnoor University—represented by the Department of Physical Education and Sports Sciences—officially inaugurated the modern Physiology and Biomechanics Laboratory in a significant scientific step aimed at enhancing the quality of education and scientific research and keeping pace with global developments in sports science and human performance. This advanced laboratory integrates physiological measurement with biomechanical analysis and has been equipped with the latest digital systems and technologies for high-precision human motion analysis, including the PODIUM system for 3D biomechanical analysis and the integrated BTS SPORTLAB system, both of which provide a sophisticated scientific environment for studying athletic performance. The laboratory represents a genuine support for developing the capabilities of students and researchers by linking theoretical knowledge with practical application and improving the efficiency of sports training. It also contributes to serving the sports community by offering scientific consultations, enhancing performance, and preventing sports injuries.

### College of Law and Political Science

Under the patronage and in the presence of Professor Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University, the activities of the First Student Conference of the College of Law and Political Science were launched under the title “Legal Perspectives on Achieving Sustainable Development,” held over two days with broad academic and official attendance. On the same day, Alnoor University received Judge Ashraf Al-Abbadi, who was welcomed by the University President, the Dean of the College of Law and Political Science, and Mr. Saleh Al-Jubouri, Head of the Nineveh Bar Assignment Committee. The delegation then proceeded to the moot court to observe a mock trial session presented by the college’s students as part of the conference activities. The judge’s visit aimed to support the practical aspect of legal education by sharing his extensive judicial expertise and providing scientific guidance and feedback to enhance students’ skills and professional readiness in the legal field. On the second day, the conference featured the presentation of five graduation research papers by five student groups, addressing diverse legal and political topics that reflected a high academic standard and serious research efforts. Following the presentations and discussions, certificates of appreciation were awarded to all participating students in recognition of their efforts and to encourage them to continue their academic and research journeys.

### College of Arts

The Department of Translation at the College of Arts, Alnoor University, in cooperation with the Continuing Education Center, organized a scientific workshop entitled “Translation as a Creative and Cognitive Process,” attended by Professor Dr. Wael Al-Nahhas, Dean of the College of Arts. The workshop addressed the concept of translation as a creative and knowledge-based process that goes beyond the literal transfer of texts to include the reconstruction of meaning in ways that align with different cultural and linguistic contexts. It also highlighted the role of the translator in building bridges of knowledge between peoples and promoting cultural understanding. The workshop was moderated and presented by lecturer Abdullah Saud Abdulmohsen, who reviewed the challenges faced by translators and the mechanisms for developing creative and cognitive skills in the field of translation.

### College of Arts

In line with its efforts to link academic curricula with practical application, the Department of Clinical Psychology at the College of Arts, Alnoor University, organized a scientific visit for its students to Al-Salam Teaching Hospital. ### College of Law and Political Science

In the presence of Professor Dr. Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, President of Alnoor University, the Department of Law at the College of Law and Political Science organized a specialized training course entitled “Procedures of Litigation in the Personal Status Court,” under the supervision of the Dean of the College, Dr. Ahmed Mustafa. The course included a series of scientific lectures delivered by Judge Saad Wadallah Nayef Al-Nuaimi, along with Dr. Fares Ahmed Ismail, Dr. Rana Saad Shaker, and Dr. Bashar Rashid, faculty members of the college, who addressed the legal and procedural aspects related to the progress of cases in the Personal Status Court, starting from filing a lawsuit through to the issuance of a judgment. The course was attended by the Assistant Administrative President of the University, the Scientific Advisor, as well as a distinguished group of students and interested participants, and aimed to enhance their applied legal knowledge and bridge the gap between theoretical concepts and practical application within the courts.

### College of Engineering

The Department of Construction Engineering and Project Management at the College of Engineering, Alnoor University, organized a scientific field trip for first-year students to the Badush Cement Plant under the supervision of Professor Dr. Saad Al-Ta'an, Dean of the College of Engineering, accompanied by a number of faculty members. During the visit, students were introduced to the plant's operational mechanisms and the stages of cement production, starting from the extraction of raw materials, through grinding and burning processes, and ending with packaging and distribution. This provided them with an opportunity to gain firsthand insight into the real work environment and the demands of the labor market in this field. The students also attended a detailed briefing by the plant's technical and engineering staff on the modern technologies used, occupational safety procedures, and the challenges facing the cement industry.

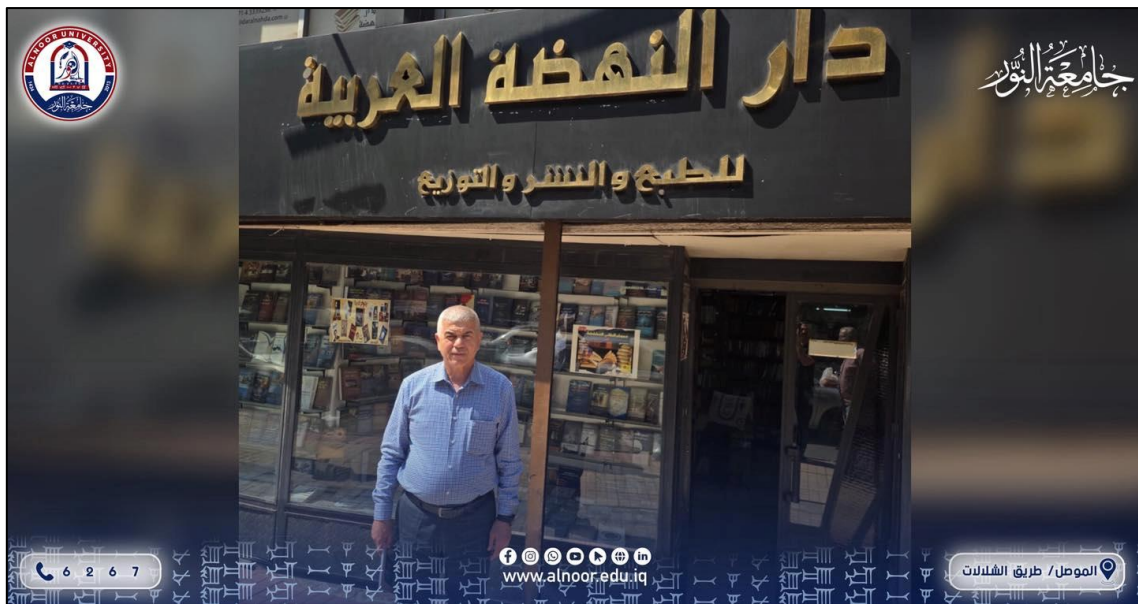
### College of Health and Medical Technologies

As part of enhancing practical aspects and linking theoretical knowledge with real-life application, the Department of Clinical Nutrition at the College of Health and Medical Technologies, Alnoor University, organized a scientific visit for its students to the Department of Food Sciences at the College of Agriculture and Forestry, University of Mosul, under the supervision of Dr. Waleed Al-Layla, Head of the Department. During the visit, students toured the specialized laboratories and facilities, where they were introduced to the latest technologies used in food analysis and quality assessment, as well as laboratory procedures and workflows. They also received a detailed explanation from the academic staff at the College of Agriculture and Forestry regarding the equipment used and the methods of conducting laboratory tests, which helped enhance their practical understanding of clinical nutrition concepts. This visit comes within a series of scientific activities that the department is keen to organize in order to develop students' skills and better prepare them for the labor market.

As part of its ongoing efforts to modernize learning resources and supply its libraries with the latest academic references, a delegation from Alnoor University visited the headquarters of Dar Al-Nahda Al-Arabiya for Printing, Publishing, and Distribution in Cairo, Egypt. The delegation included Professor Dr. Ismail Abdulwahab, Assistant President of the University for Scientific Affairs; Professor Dr. Ahmed Mustafa Ali, Dean of the College of Law and Political Science; and Dr. Mohammed Zuhair Zaidan, Director of Cultural Relations at the university. During the visit, an agreement was reached on a mechanism to equip the Central Library of Alnoor University and the Library of the College of Law and Political Science with a wide range of the latest publications and legal works, including seminal texts in civil, criminal, and international law, in addition to specialized academic journals. This step comes to ensure the provision of a solid research environment for students and faculty members, and to give researchers access to the latest developments in legal scholarship and modern legislation, thereby enhancing Alnoor University's position as a distinguished center of academic and scientific excellence.

The university team delivered an exceptional performance throughout the tournament, eliminating the University of Technology team in the semifinals before concluding its golden journey with a remarkable victory over the University of Kirkuk team in the final round, thus claiming the championship title. The ambitions of Alnoor extended beyond the team title to dominate individual excellence awards as well. Debater Baraa Maher Abdul Jabbar was crowned Best Speaker in Iraq, while Darwish Rashu Darwish earned recognition as one of the top ten speakers in the tournament. Meanwhile, team members Mohammed Khalid Thanoon and student Maysar Ammar Maysar played pivotal roles in achieving this success. This accomplishment is the result of sustained effort by a dedicated and integrated university team that worked to establish strong foundations for debating, which have borne fruit after a long period of planning, determination, and training. The team was supervised by the university's debating activities coordinator, Assistant Lecturer Saad Saleh Dhiab, and the debating team supervisor, Assistant Lecturer Anfal Ghanem Yassin.

### College of Health and Medical Technologies

The Department of Medical Laboratory Technologies organized a scientific visit to the Quality Control Department at the Nineveh Water Directorate, with the participation of several fourth-year graduation project supervisors and a group of their students. The visit aimed to familiarize students with the modern equipment and techniques used in testing and analyzing drinking water. Specialists at the directorate provided a detailed explanation of laboratory workflows, methods for measuring concentrations of elements and chemical substances, as well as quality control procedures and water quality assurance. The visit witnessed active student engagement, as they were given the opportunity to conduct some practical tests under the supervision of technical staff, which contributed to enhancing their applied skills and developing their scientific capabilities. The visit also included an exchange of knowledge and expertise on methods of treating water pollution, particularly in well water and certain areas of the Tigris River, in addition to discussing the most prominent environmental challenges and proposed solutions to reduce the impact of pollutants on water sources. This visit comes as part of Alnoor University's commitment to developing students' skills and strengthening cooperation with service institutions, contributing to the preparation of qualified scientific cadres that meet the needs of the labor market.

Alnoor University received the National Evaluation Team affiliated with the Iraqi Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education at the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research on an official visit aimed at initiating procedures for granting program accreditation to the Department of English at the College of Education. On the first day, the visit included field tours of several classrooms, laboratories, and educational facilities, as well as a review of supporting evidence, in addition to meetings with the university presidency, college administration, and relevant committees, during which strategic plans, quality assurance mechanisms, and continuous improvement processes were presented. The committee commended the efforts made and the advanced progress achieved by the university in this field. This visit comes within the framework of the Ministry's follow-up on accreditation program and its continuous support for educational institutions to enhance the quality of higher education in Iraq. On the second day, the team continued academic and administrative audits, reviewing files and documents related to accreditation standards, as well as monitoring the implementation of educational plans and quality assurance mechanisms in accordance with the council's approved standards. The visit also included expanded meetings with concerned committees and faculty members to assess academic performance and the level of implementation of program accreditation requirements, thereby enhancing the quality of educational outcomes and reinforcing institutional development standards. Alnoor University affirmed its ongoing commitment to providing an integrated educational environment that meets quality and accreditation requirements and aligns with the Ministry's direction toward developing higher education institutions in Iraq.
