

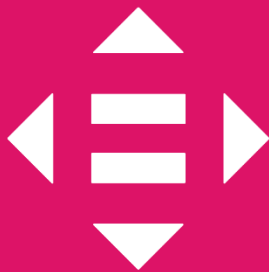

10 REDUCED INEQUALITIES



Global inequality is increasing, with 1% of the world's population holding nearly half of the global wealth. Goal 10 of the Sustainable Development Goals aims to ensure equal opportunities by adopting legislation and following policies that improve living conditions for everyone in a sustainable manner. Special attention must be given to the most vulnerable countries, such as the least developed countries and small island developing states, particularly through directing financial flows to them.

Reduced Inequalities

The Human Rights Division at the Presidency of Alnoor University organized a scientific workshop entitled “Workers’ Rights in National and International Legislation.” The workshop was supervised by lecturer Qidar Ahmed Mahmoud and featured lectures delivered by Dr. Hani Younis Ahmed, Dr. Luay Hikmat, and Mr. Raad Ismail Hassan Al-Badrani, Director of the Retirement and Social Security Department for Workers in Nineveh, along with a number of specialists and individuals interested in legal and human rights affairs. The workshop addressed the key rights guaranteed to workers by national and international legislation, highlighting legal protection mechanisms, the importance of raising awareness of workers’ rights, and the role of official institutions in ensuring their fair and effective implementation. The workshop concluded with discussions and interventions that emphasized the importance of continuing to hold such events to enhance legal culture and human rights awareness within both academic and community environments. Coinciding with International Workers’ Day, the event also included the honoring of a group of Alnoor University staff members in recognition of their dedication and continuous efforts in serving the educational institution.
