Partnerships For The Goals

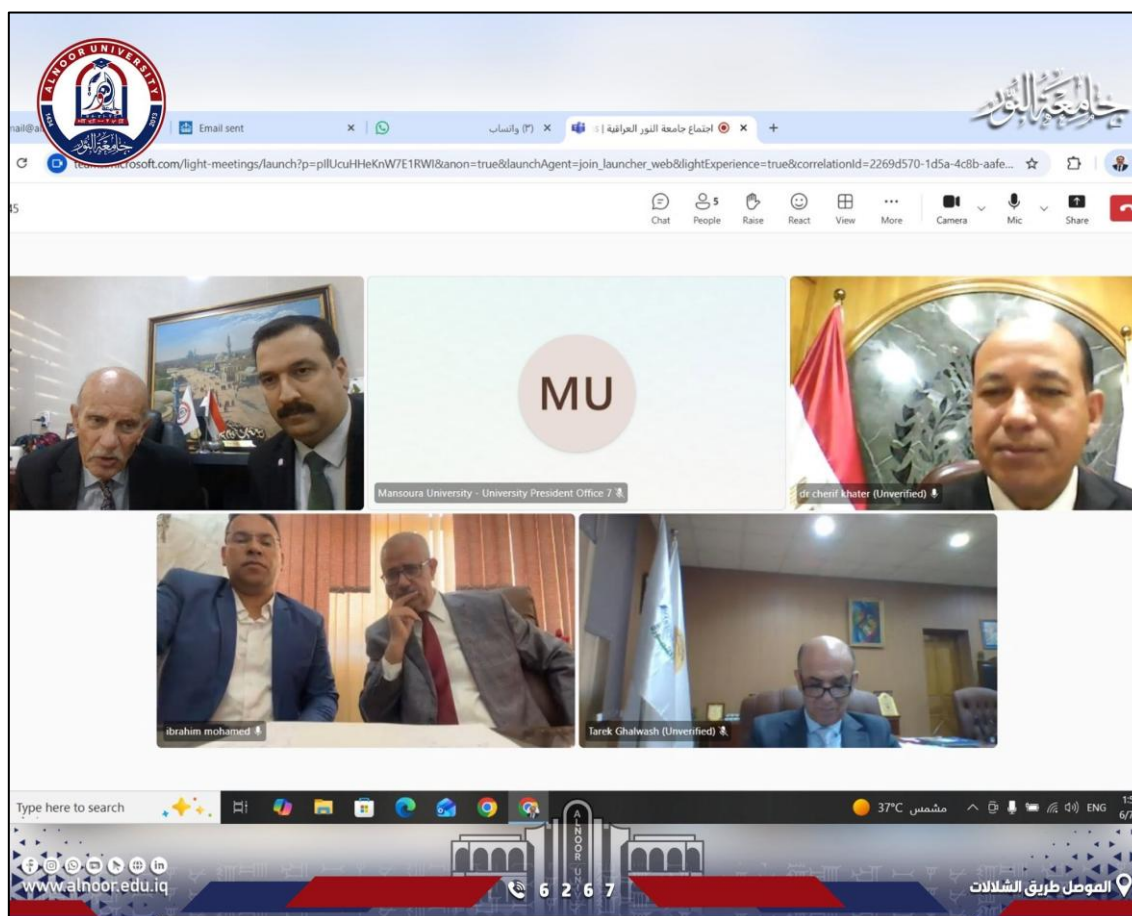

Partnerships For The Goals

Alnoor University held a joint virtual meeting with Mansoura University of Egypt as part of both institutions' efforts to strengthen scientific and academic cooperation and exchange expertise in research and education, particularly in the fields of law, political science, and postgraduate studies. Representing Alnoor University were Professor Yaseen Taha Al-Hajjar, President of the University; Assistant Professor Dr. Ismail Abdulwahab Ismail, Assistant President of the University; Assistant Professor Dr. Ahmed Mustafa Ali, Dean of the College of Law and Political Science; and Assistant Professor Dr. Bashar Rashid Hussein, Assistant Dean and Head of the Department of Law. Representing Mansoura University were Professor Sherif Youssef Khater, President of the University; Professor Tarek Mostafa Alloush, Vice President for Graduate Studies and Research; Professor Walid Mohamed El-Shenawy, Dean of the Faculty of Law; and Professor Ibrahim Abdullah Abdel Raouf, Vice Dean for Graduate Studies and Research. During the meeting, both sides discussed avenues for enhancing cooperation in scientific research, academic supervision, the organization of joint scientific activities, and the exchange of expertise between corresponding colleges, in addition to exploring opportunities for future academic partnerships that would support the scientific and research missions of both institutions. The participants emphasized the importance of the meeting as a significant step toward expanding cooperation between Iraqi and Egyptian universities and strengthening their joint academic presence in legal, humanities, and scientific fields, thereby contributing to the advancement of higher education and scientific research in both brotherly countries.



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As part of its commitment to supporting investment and strengthening partnerships between academic institutions and the private sector, the Chairman of the Board of Trustees of Alnoor University, Dr. Bashar Mahmoud Ali, accompanied by Nineveh Deputy Governor Mr. Khalid Al-Obaidi, conducted a field visit to the Green City Residential Complex located on Al-Qaida Road on the right bank of Mosul to review the project's progress and ongoing urban development. The delegation was welcomed by the project management, which expressed its interest in enhancing cooperation with Alnoor University and accompanied the visitors on a tour of the complex's various facilities, residential units, services, and infrastructure. The delegation was briefed on the level of completion, quality of construction, and modern architectural designs that distinguish the complex, which is considered one of the leading and promising investment projects in Nineveh Province due to its significant contribution to the housing sector, urban development, and the broader reconstruction and investment movement in Mosul. Dr. Bashar Mahmoud Ali emphasized the importance of encouraging high-quality investment projects that contribute to infrastructure development and the creation of integrated urban environments, praising the efforts of the project management and the substantial progress achieved. During the visit, both parties agreed to explore avenues for joint cooperation between Alnoor University and the project administration by providing practical training opportunities for students of various engineering departments, enabling them to gain direct exposure to major engineering projects and acquire hands-on experience that enhances their readiness for the labor market. This visit reflects Alnoor University's commitment to strengthening partnerships with investment and development projects across Nineveh Province and linking academic education with practical application, thereby contributing to the preparation of qualified engineering professionals capable of supporting reconstruction, development, and sustainable growth.

College of Law and Political Science

As part of the distinguished academic presence of Alnoor University faculty members and in support of scientific cooperation among Iraqi universities, Professor Hassan Mohammed Ali Al-Bannan, a faculty member at the College of Law and Political Science at Alnoor University, chaired the PhD dissertation defense committee at the College of Law, University of Mosul. The defense was held within the field of Public Law for the dissertation entitled “Legislative Policy of General Administrative Procedures: A Comparative Study,” submitted by doctoral candidate Ahmed Saleh Awwad Atiya Al-Khalaf, in the presence of a number of academics and specialists. The selection of Professor Al-Bannan to chair the committee reflects the scientific competence and academic expertise of Alnoor University’s faculty members, as well as their active role in supporting the scientific and research process and participating in academic committees across Iraqi universities.



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College of Law and Political Science
